



Intranet system helps people work together

Danish developer sets up in Auckland

An intranet-based system claimed to facilitate the way we work together in projects and between partners and suppliers has arrived in New Zealand.

Quickplace also comes as a hosted service and is developed by CrossWare of Denmark, which has now opened an Auckland office.

Solutions include knowledge management, quality management, distributed learning, advanced Web design and Internet management using Lotus Notes and Lotus Domino.

"Quickplace improves team communication and enhances efficiency by compressing cycle times and improving the quality of team results. People use QuickPlace to plan events, facilitate an acquisition, brainstorm a new sales strategy, respond to an RFP or oversee a product rollout," says CrossWare spokesperson Per Anderson.

"And because QuickPlace breaks down the barriers to working together outside the firewall, secure Web collaboration with suppliers, partners and customers is only seconds away."
